# How do we live an integrated life with proper life priorities?

I find this a challenge ever since the day I said to Jesus '*Count me in, I want to follow you*.' There have been times of anguish when 'I' have tried 'to do much' for the Gospel of Jesus Christ, and equally when 'I' have tried 'to pull back from doing', having miss-construed the text 'Be still and know I am God'. (Psalm 46:10)

It seems that 2 Timothy 2:1 has some helpful advice for us to remember. "You then, my child, be strengthened by the grace that is in Christ Jesus;" If I am 'In Christ', then that is because of God's grace. It is God's grace that has brought me into the transforming relationship with Jesus. It is God's grace and love that compels me to engage in helping others become disciple-makers. I have to be available for God to work through me.

But!! What about the things that happen and the relationships that are part of living in a family? What about that part of living that we call work?

I found it significant that the Korean CBMC National Convention this year addressed this matter comprehensively. It seems that too many members compartmentalise their lives instead of living integrated lives. The result is Jesus is pushed aside and does not have a position in the person's conduct of their business, nor in the family relationships until next Sunday when they head off to Church.

#### Psalm 119:35-37 (NIV) {My emphasis}

**Direct me in the path of your commands**, for there I find delight.**Turn my heart toward your statutes** and not toward selfish gain.**Turn my eyes away from worthless things**; preserve my life according to your word.

Psalm119:35 mentions God's commands. Jesus summarised the commandments in this fashion (Matthew 22:37-39) "Jesus replied: Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind. This is the first and greatest commandment. And the second is like it: Love your neighbour as yourself."


